2025 FEMALE WORLD SPORT SCHOOL CHALLENGE TOURNAMENT RULES

1. GAME FORMAT

Each game will be preceded by a 7 minute on ice warm-up; puck drop will follow immediately, there will not be ice resurfacing. The length of all games will be three (3) twenty minute (20) stop time periods. The ice will be resurfaced before each period unless otherwise instructed by the event Chair. In the event that a game results in a tie at the completion of regulation time, the game will proceed to the Overtime format as detailed in item 2d.

2. THE TOURNAMENT WILL BE PLAYED UNDER OFFICIAL HOCKEY CANADA RULES WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS

- No Change on Icings: Teams guilty of "Icing the Puck" will not be allowed to make a line change on that stoppage of play.
- Face-off following a Penalty being assessed will take place in the defensive zone of the offending team.
- Mercy Rule: In games #1 through #18, when a team is winning by 5 or more goals at the midway mark (10-minute mark) of the 3rd period "running time" shall be played and will continue unless a difference of less than 5 goals occurs at which time the game will revert to "stop time". Penalties assessed when Mercy Rule is in effect will be run-time as well; if game play reverts to "stop time" and any penalty remaining will also revert to stop time.
- Overtime for tied games: All overtime periods of Games # 1 through #26 shall be played with each team at the numerical strength of 3 skaters and 1 goalkeeper. The goaltenders will defend the same goal during overtime as in the 3rd period.
- **a.** In the Preliminary Round games (Games #1-18): the teams will have a 2-minute intermission on the ice after which a 5 minute "sudden victory" overtime period will be played with 3 skaters and 1 goalkeeper for each team. If the game is still tied then a shoot-out will take place to determine a winner. The teams will defend the same goal during overtime and shoot-out as in the third period.
- **b.** In Play-off Round games (Games #19-24): the teams will have a 2-minute intermission on the ice after which a 5 minute "sudden victory" overtime period will be played with 3 skaters and 1 goalkeeper for each team. If the game is still tied then a shoot-out will take place to determine a winner. The teams will defend the same goal during overtime and shoot-out as in the third period.
- **c. In the Bronze Medal game (Game #25):** the teams will have a 2-minute intermission on the ice after which a 5 minute "sudden victory" overtime period will be played with 3 skaters and 1 goalkeeper for each team. If the game is still tied then a shoot-out will take place to determine a winner. The teams will defend the same goal during overtime and shoot-out as in the third period.
- **d.** In the Championship Gold Medal game (Game #26): the teams will have a 2-minute intermission on the ice after which a 10-minute "sudden-victory" overtime period will be played with 3 skaters and 1 goalkeeper for each team. If the game is still tied, then a shoot-out will take place to determine a winner. The goaltenders will defend the same goal for the shoot-out as in the overtime period.

3. POINT ALLOCATION

- Three (3) points will be awarded for a win in regulation time.
- In a game that requires Overtime or Shoot-out to determine a winner; the winning team will be awarded two (2) points and the losing team will be awarded one (1) point.

4. SHOOT-OUT GUIDELINES

- The Home Team has the choice of which team will shoot first.
- Each team does not need to name their first 3 shooters prior to start of game.
- If still tied after the initial round of 3 shooters per team the Shoot-Out will continue as a single player shoot-out.
- Any eligible player on the game roster can shoot in this next series of shots, except for players serving penalties at end of Overtime.
- Goaltenders shall defend the same goal as in the overtime period.
